MEASURING FOR BRACELETS

1. To find your bracelet size, wrap a soft measuring tape tightly around your wrist just below the wrist bone, noting the length where the measuring tape meets. If you do not have a measuring tape, please use our printable measuring tool found in the download link below.

2. Find your wrist measurement on the chart above. Please note sizes differ slightly depending on the bracelet type; make sure you are referencing the correct chart when determining your size.
3. If on the cusp of two sizes, select the size based on your personal preference. If you prefer a tighter fit, select the smaller size. If you prefer a looser fit, select the larger size. Please note, as our bracelets are crafted for maximum comfort, allow for an extra $\frac{1}{4}$ " tolerance.
4. When selecting your size for bracelets featuring Dragon (Naga) or Eagle head clasps, we recommend sizing down if on the cusp of two sizes. Due to the extra weight of the clasps, these bracelets tend to spin around, with the head on the bottom of the wrist if the fit is loose.

MEASURING FOR RINGS

1. To find your ring size, wrap a soft measuring tape around the base of the finger you intend to wear the ring on, noting the length where the measuring tape meets. If you do not have a measuring tape, please use our printable measuring tool found in the download link below.

2. Your dominant hand is generally slightly larger than your non-dominant hand.

3. For more prominent knuckles, we recommend measuring the base of your finger and knuckle; choose a size in between, allowing the ring to fit over your knuckle but not be too loose at the base of your finger.

MEASURING FOR NECKLACES

1. Necklaces vary by chain length, and the circumference of your neck and the size and weight of the style will impact how your necklace sits on its own and with other styles.
2. To determine where the specific necklace lengths may fall, we recommend measuring an existing necklace from clasp to clasp to determine length, then comparing it to the chart below.
3. Alternately, measure a piece of string to the necklace length you are considering, and place it around your neck to determine where the necklace may fall. Please note the necklace style and weight will affect how the piece lays.
